Our **World Polio Day Tea Party** is being held as part of a campaign by **Rotary International** to raise funds to continue the worldwide immunisation programmes to help eradicate polio throughout the world and remove the risk of its return.

Polio is a highly contagious virus which primarily attacks children under five, leading to paralysis or even death.

Rotary International's programme to rid the world of polio has been described as one of the finest humanitarian projects ever known, which has even earned **Rotary** a nomination for the Nobel Peace Prize.

Although the disease has not been seen in the UK for many years, continuing efforts are required to eliminate it worldwide in order that it can never return.

When polio is finally eradicated it will be one of the most significant achievements in public health since the eradication of smallpox.

Rotary in the UK has donated well over **£20 million** (€24 million) to the **End Polio Now** campaign.
