4. ANNUAL REPORT 2017/18 BY THE CHAIRMAN

Cllr Piper reviewed the past year's achievements which include the installation of some new play ground equipment and also two new defibrillators. Along with these defibrillators the Council has arranged for training sessions on their use and the village now has a Village Emergency Telephone System (known as VETS) which has ten members who are available to assist in cases of emergency. Looking to the future Cllr Piper referred to improvements in the playing field which will include new bases for some of the play equipment and also changes to the entrance/exit onto Oak Road for safety reasons. The Council is now looking into the posibility of siting and investigating funding grants for a mobile phone mast to serve the community. Cllr Piper also referred to the Parochial Church Council's proposal to build a Parish Room adjacent to the Church; this is a major project will be considered by the Parish Council at future meetings as the plans develop.
