

Theft from Vans

Vans have been entered and tools have been removed, if you own or know a neighbour, friend or workmate who owns a van make them aware. Think



about security. If you have tools on board think about removing them overnight if possible and add signage to your vehicle to indicate you have done so. Also make a point of property marking your equipment both overtly and covertly.

- Don't tempt thieves by leaving any items on display.
- **Do clean off the sat nav ring** off the windscreen.
- Do turn off bluetooth- it can be detected when on.
- **Do** lock your vehicle at all times, close windows, and set the alarm, even when parked on your driveway or when carrying out any work.
- Do park rear doors on vans up against garage doors.
- Do not just press the button on your fob to lock it Look at your car to see the lights flash etc to confirm locking; someone may be nearby with a "remote blocker" and stop your car from locking.
- Do try to park in a secure, well lit area where possible, if parking at a hotel try and park within view of reception, CCTV cameras or your room.
- Do mark tools and property visibly with your post code and house number, and consider products such as CRE Mark, Selecta DNA and Smart Water.
- **Do** register serial numbers of your property on www.immobilise.com this is completely free service.
- **Do consider** having additional security door locks fitted, they make it harder for the thief and are a great visual deterrent.
- **Do consider** having a safe box secured within the vehicle.
- **Do consider** a PIR alarm that calls you on the mobile phone when activated, intended for sheds work just as well in a van.
- If using a public car park Try to use a "Parkmark" approved car park www.parkmark.co.uk

Empty your car before someone else does.





Gestingthorpe's Defibrillator

After so many reports in recent Parish News giving updates on the defibrillator project for Gestingthorpe, it is especially good to report that we now have a working system and a defibrillator that can be collected in case of a cardiac emergency from our former telephone box.

The first action that must be taken in any serious emergency is to call 999, when the answering paramedic will guide the caller through potentially life-saving actions and will indicate if the defibrillator is likely to be needed.

On Wednesday, 10 January there was a very good turnout of people from the village to listen to an excellent talk given by Martin Render from the Community Heartbeat Trust (CHT). One of Martin's aim was to make us all aware that the defibrillator can save lives and that it is impossible to use it inappropriately - the modern machines will not give the shock if the heart rhythm indicates that it is not necessary.

The CHT has been supporting and helping throughout the project and will indeed, continue to do so. However, the defibrillator is of no use if there is no-one present to fetch it, as the victim of sudden cardiac arrest must not be left alone. We are now in the process of setting up a scheme such as

Pebmarsh has, which will allow another volunteer to go to the victim to help. As soon as the telephone number for that line is available it will be publicised.








Taking Community Responsibility for the Environment...

Great Maplestead Parish Council is backing an initiative to encourage parishioners to take personal responsibility for helping to maintain and improve the local environment.

The aim of this initiative is to demonstrate how small individual actions – ones that anyone can undertake with only a little amount of effort – can have a significant impact on improving the environment in which we live.

Here are just a few examples of the sort of things which can make a real difference:

Picking up Litter:

Although the Task Force undertakes regular Litter Picks during the course of each year, the sadly inevitable accumulation of rubbish in between times is both unsightly and a hazard to wildlife.

This could be reduced considerably if everyone walking the local footpaths or roads regularly picked up and bagged any odd pieces of litter they saw and put them in their recycling bins. Taking personal responsibility for such actions would be a tremendous help in minimising the worst effects of littering.

Cleaning/Painting Road Signs:

The Council is also looking for volunteers for an Adopt-a-Sign programme, to be responsible for the occasional cleaning/painting of a road sign near them.

Improving the Surroundings:

Late last year the three road-junction triangles in the village were 'adopted' by volunteers who offered to keep these essentially public spaces tidy and prevent them becoming neglected.

This has already seen positive benefits for the village – the Church Street triangle has been planted with crocuses and its

various items of furniture cleaned and varnished whilst the Barretts Hall triangle has also been mowed and tidied.

Elsewhere, volunteers will shortly be planting flowers around the Children's Play Area, to create a more environmentally-friendly border.

The Council is encouraging people to act as Community Custodians and take pride in participating in initiatives such as those outlined above to benefit the local environment.


